**Position Title: Visiting/Assistant/Associate/Full Professor of Department of Animal Science and Biotechnology, Tunghai University, Taichung, TAIWAN**

### **Faculty Position Announcement**

The College of Agriculture's Department of Animal Science and Biotechnology at Tunghai University in Taiwan is seeking candidates for the position of Visiting Professor, Assistant Professor, Associate Professor or Full Professor. The expected start date for the position is August 1, 2016.

**Responsibilities:** The successful candidate will be responsible for the development of an independent research program in her/his area of scientific expertise of high relevance to Reproductive Technology, Dairy Production, Animal Nutrition. The successful candidate will also be responsible for assuming a key role in the Department's undergraduate teaching program which will include instruction of 2-4 undergraduate courses in English each year that are in direct support of the Department's course plans. Participation in the departmental graduate program is also expected. The successful candidate will be expected to function effectively on multidisciplinary teams, develop collaborative relationships with faculty in the department and across the college. Service to the department, college and university are expected. Professors on sabbatical leave are welcome to apply for visiting positions.

**Qualifications:** Minimum qualifications include an earned Ph.D. in Animal Science, or closely related field. Candidates must have the qualifications, experience, and resolve to develop a research program in a core scientific discipline relevant to animal science and biotechnology. Candidates must demonstrate that they have a successful publication record and have secured/attempted to obtain extramural funding commensurate with their experience. Potential ability to successfully obtain extramural funding is essential. The successful candidate must have documented experience and/or evidence of the ability to function as an effective instructor at the undergraduate level. Candidates must also demonstrate the ability to work cooperatively with faculty, students and industry to develop collaborative research

and teaching programs. Excellent interpersonal skills and the ability to effectively interact with diverse audiences are required.

Salary will be commensurate with experience and education. On-campus housing is available for the first two years of appointment free of rent (utility fees not included). The University will help with the application for working visa/permit if needed.

Application: Applicants must submit all application materials including: a list of publication in five years (with one representative paper published in three years), diploma of the highest degree, current vita, copies of all transcripts (BS, MS, and PhD), participated research projects and a list of courses anticipated to teach, which would fit into the departmental goals in core educational discipline (please refer to <http://animal.thu.edu.tw/en/index.htm> for the goals), and two professional references to:
